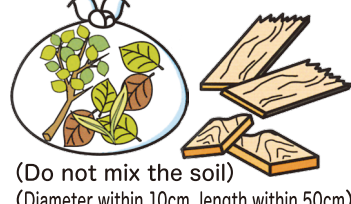
Disposable Diapers

(Flush faces down the toilet)

- ◆ Containers and wrapping paper made with vinyl-coated paper, gold or silver foil; letters and envelopes; household containers and bags; delivery paper bags and boxes from couriers; and boxes with food residue should be disposed of as burnable waste.
- ◆ If you have more than three bags at a time, please take them to the Environmental Center.

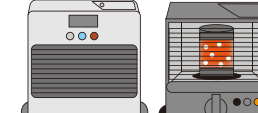
Non-burnable waste

(If you put it in a bag, please put it in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.)

Metal (Items with metal parts)

Fan Heaters, Oil Stoves

(Completely remove kerosene and batteries)

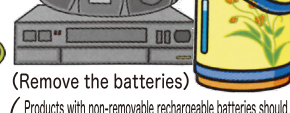

(Products with non-removable rechargeable batteries should be disposed of as "hazardous waste, rechargeable products.")

(Fluorescent lights are hazardous waste)



Light Bulbs

(Fluorescent lights are hazardous waste)



- ◆ We do not collect washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators (including freezers), televisions, or air conditioners. Please arrange for disposal through an appliance retailer or a designated recycling association collection point (see each manufacturer's website).
- ◆ Empty canned food, tempura oil cans, etc. before disposal. (For tempura oil, soak it into cloth or newspaper, or solidify it with a commercially available coagulant, then dispose of it as burnable waste.)
- ◆ For dangerous items such as broken glass or razor blades, place them in a can or wrap them in paper before disposal.
- ◆ We do not collect long or heavy items that cannot be loaded onto the collection truck. (As a guideline: length up to 1 m, weight up to 20 kg.)
- ◆ Non-burnable waste should be separated into two categories: metal, and glass/other.

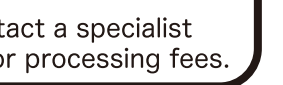
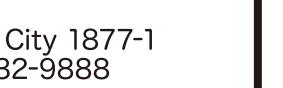
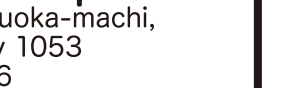
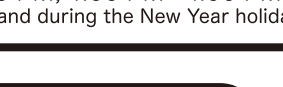
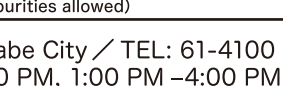
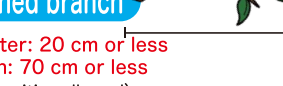
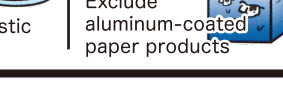
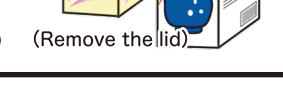
Glass/other

(Please put it in a can or wrap it in paper)



Disposable Heat Packs

(Bags are container and packaging waste)



- ◆ "Plastic recyclables" are items containing about 80% or more plastic, with each side 50cm or less. (If over 50cm → "Glass/other.")
- ◆ Please rinse plastic bags, containers, cans, and bottles before disposal.
- ◆ Put "Paper Containers and Packaging" waste into a paper bag or tie with white paper string. (Each side ≤ 50cm. Keep dry.)
- ◆ Remove any metal fittings from food plastic wrap or aluminum foil boxes and classify as "Non-burnable waste."
- ◆ Remove non-paper handles from paper bags → "Plastic recyclables."
- ◆ Remove caps from glass bottles and sort by material.
- ◆ If the color of a bottle is unclear, put it into the black-glass container. (Sort vinegar bottles by color.)
- ◆ Cut open beverage cartons, rinse with water, dry thoroughly, then dispose.

Hazardous waste

(Check the sorting containers and place items in the correct location.)

- ◆ "Hazardous waste" products contain heavy metals. Place in a clear plastic bag to prevent breakage, then dispose in the separate collection container.
- ◆ Button and rechargeable batteries can be returned to the store where purchased.
- ◆ Products with non-removable rechargeable batteries, such as heated tobacco products, should be placed in a clear plastic bag to protect from water, then dispose in the separate collection container.

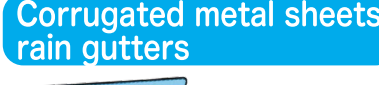

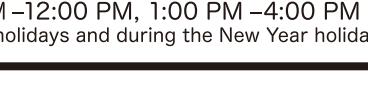

◆ Size Restrictions for Combustible Bulky Waste

Wood furniture such as chests	1.3m x 2.3m x 0.6m or smaller
Lumber	Diameter 20cm or less, length up to 2.3m
Carpets	Fold without rolling
futons	As is / In its original state
tatami mats	As is / In its original state
